Summer 2024 Plans

We will be offering a Summer Camp as well as an Extended Day Camp and

School Age Camp over the summer months. Our 9-1 Summer Camp will run for 8 weeks, starting on June 10. We will be closed this summer on Thursday, July 4th and Friday, July 5th, as well as Monday, August 26th and Monday, September 2nd for the entire school. Our Extended Day Camp and School Age classrooms will be open 7:30 AM-5:30 PM effective Monday, June 3rd.

We are excited that we will be having a summer camp again this year. We will be having an eight-week program, beginning June 10 and ending August 9th. The camp will meet from 9:00-1:00 each day Monday-Friday. You can sign-up for one, two, or all eight weeks. The cost will be \$175 each week. There is a 5% discount if you sign up for all 8 weeks! We also give a discount for siblings that enroll. If we have enough interest in a 2-year old camp, we will open room 2 for our younger friends. Children in this classroom do not need to be potty trained but will need to turn 2 before June 10, 2024.

The registration form will be a google form just like our regular registration. The link will be posted to the school story Monday, February 5th at 10 AM. This program sometimes fills up with our in-house families, so please sign up if you are interested. There is not a registration fee, however, to reserve a spot, you must deposit a \$50 reservation fee at the time of registration. The remainder of the tuition will be due the Wednesday before each week.

Our extended day camp classrooms (Rooms 3 and 4) as well as our school age classroom will also follow the themes these weeks. The weekly tuition of \$290 for these rooms will be due on the Monday of the week enrolled. Please see below for more details about class options. Feel free to talk to someone in the front office if you have questions.

The children will benefit from lots of outdoor play, music and movement activities as well as sensory experiences. We also have lots of fun, in house field trips, planned as well! The School Age calendar will be posted later next week that will show all of the fun field trips planned. The School Age Camp is for children entering 2nd-5th grade.

The teachers are busy planning lots of fun experiences for the children. The weekly themes are listed below:

June 10-14
Under the Big Top
We will kick off our summer camp with Mike the Magician visiting us this week. We will conduct LOTS of science experiments, including several that will result in delicious treats!

June 17-21
Pirates and Princesses
Who doesn't love to pretend in dramatic play? We will read lots of favorite fairy tales and retell stories using the puppet theatre.
We will "walk the plank" and have a treasure hunt!



June 24-28 Under the Sea

Let's explore life under the ocean- including SHARKS! We will investigate sea life as well as use all of our senses to explore the sensory bin. We will take a virtual field trip to the Aquarium!

July 8-12

It's a Bugs Life- Camping

Let's go camping under the stars! We will make smore's, have an outdoor picnic and sing songs around the campfire. We will bring our bikes/scooters and have a bike day this week!

July 15-19 *Dinosaurs!*

Have you ever danced the diosaur stomp?
This week we will go back in history and
learn all about volcanos and have lots of
scientific investigations!

July 22-26 Out of This World

This week will focus on space and our solar system. We will play games outside, as well as enjoy lots of STEM activities! Eric Energy will also visit us this week.

July 29- August 2 Summer Olympics

We will kick off the week visiting Tri-Star Martial Arts in Mount Airy. Throughout the week we will experience lots of movement both inside and outside. We will bring our bikes/scooters and have a bike day this week!

August 5-9
Water, Water, Everywhere!
Children will have fun in the sun as they explore water everywhere. We will visit the Aquarium with a virtual field trip and have a WATER DAY! We will investigate sink or float, and we will discover how long it takes popsicles to melt!

Details...

- Registration will begin at 10:00 AM on February 5th.
- Attendance is flexible for the Summer Camps and School Agers. You can choose one week, two weeks, or all 8! Our Extended Day Camp and School Age classrooms are open ALL summer, with the exception of July 4-5 and Monday, August 26.

A non-refundable \$50 reservation fee will be due upon registration for each week you are registering for the Summer 9-1 Camp. This means if you are registering for 3 weeks, you will pay a \$150 reservation fee to hold your place. This applies to anyone registering for the 9-1 Summer Camp and children that are attending the School Age Camp part time this summer. The remainder of each week's camp tuition should be paid no later than the Wednesday before your child is scheduled to attend. (This does not apply to our Extended Day Camp in Rooms 3 and 4. It also does not apply for our School Age children that will attend all summer. These



children's tuition will be due on the Monday of each school week.)

 We recommend that sun block be applied prior to arrival each day as the children will be playing outdoors. A labeled sun hat or cap is also recommended

Forms:

Completed and up to date forms, these include the Health Inventory, Emergency Card and Allergy Form (if needed) are required in the office at least a week before your child starts.

We will need Emergency Forms *updated* after June 1, 2024. Please see the office to do so.

NOTE: In the event of insufficient enrollment, parents will be notified of class cancelation two weeks prior to the first class. Fees for the class will be refunded. This does include the \$50 reservation fee.

Reminders:

- This is just a friendly reminder that we strive to maintain a healthy environment for our children and staff. There is an understanding that all children in our care can participate fully, including active play, indoors and outdoors. Please take a few minutes to review our sickness policy as stated in the Parent Handbook. Mt. Airy Daycare and Learning Center has set the following standards for the health and safety of children and staff: Your child may not come to school and will be sent home, if we notice any of the following symptoms:
 - Temperature 100°F or higher (Your child cannot return to the center until he/she is fever free for 24 hours without medication)
 - Vomiting and/or Diarrhea
 - Unidentified Rash · Conjuctivitis (Pink Eye)
 - Head Lice a child must be nit free before returning to the center
 - o Any Communicable Disease

We reserve the right to refuse admittance to any child with any of these symptoms.

 Lunch time is an important part of a child's day. This is a time that children build their peer relationships and social skills, but even more importantly children can replenish their bodies with healthy and nutritional foods. Many of the prepared meals, such as Lunchables, often contain a high amount of sodium and other preservatives. - Weather Appropriate Clothing: Classes will be going outside every day that weather permits, even in colder temperatures. Please make sure that your child wears weather appropriate clothing so he/she can enjoy the time outside. The weather is changing day by day, and even sometimes hour by hour. Please send in a jacket with your child every day. Remember to label your child's jacket. Don't forget to label "extras", such as hats, mittens and scarves!
- Extra Clothes: Please check your child's supply of extra clothes to make sure all the clothes are weather appropriate and fit properly. Remember to include extra underwear and socks.
- Absences: Please call the school to let us know when your child will not be here or is running late (301-829- 6364). You can also message your teacher on ClassDojo. This is extremely helpful to the teachers, so they may plan their days accordingly.

Inclement Weather Policy for Preschool Classes 2023-2024 School Year

Our Inclement Weather policy affects **ANY and ALL** Preschool activities (i.e. field trips, conferences, and class time).

When **Carroll** County is CLOSED, Mt. Airy Daycare & Learning Center Preschool will be **CLOSED**.

When Carroll County Schools open **1 Hour LATE** the preschool classes will begin at 10:00 A.M.

When Carroll County Schools open **2 Hours LATE** the preschool classes will also begin at 10:00 A.M.

Early Closings:

Early Closings due to bad weather will follow Carroll County Schools. Should either or both counties decide to close early, the afternoon classes will close accordingly (i.e. if schools should close one hour early, classes will dismiss one hour early.) If either of the school systems closes 2 hours or more early, the afternoon classes will be canceled.
